Awards Process

- The Reid Sacco AYA Cancer Alliance Scholarship Committee will review all application materials and will determine which applicants will be awarded scholarships.
- Recipients will be notified in late August.
- Funds are sent directly to the college the recipient will be attending.

Application Materials Needed

- Ask your Guidance Department for a copy of your most recent high school transcript.
- Obtain one letter of recommendation from a teacher, employer, coach or mentor.
- Write an essay of no more than 250 words describing why you believe Reid exemplified the values and spirit of KBIA.
- Write a second essay of no more than 250 words explaining what AYA cancer and/or the mission of the AYA Cancer Alliance means to you.

Submission of Your Application Materials

- Send a copy of this form, your letter of recommendation, your high school transcript, and your two essays to "Scholarship Selection Committee, 18 Sylvan Circle, Lynnfield, MA 01940".
